

# COURAGE

## Nehemiah 13:1–31

In the last chapter of the book of Nehemiah, we can see how Nehemiah dealt the problem that they faced when he went back to king Artaxerxes. Upon returning to Jerusalem these are the problems that he dealt with:

- 1. The problem of compromise (vv. 1–9).
- 2. The problem of not being faithful to their giving (vv. 10–14).
- 3. The problem of doing business on Sabbath (vv.15–22).
- 4. The problem of disobedience to God (vv. 23–31).

Nehemiah dealt all these problems with courage. He did not give in to compromise rather he faced the problems head-on with courage. The reason for his courage was his dependence upon the Lord. In this chapter, Nehemiah prayed four (4x) times to God (vv. 14, 22, 29, 31).

The lesson for us today is to take courage. To live a courageous life not a compromised life. The foundation of a courageous life of obedience to God is dependence on Him. We draw strength from God himself. Live a courageous life not a compromised life therefore TAKE COURAGE!

- 1. Take courage in living a life of integrity for God.
- 2. Take courage in living a life of generosity for God.
- 3. Take courage in living a life of fidelity to God.
- 4. Take courage in living a life of sincerity to God.
